

## **INTERGRAIN TIMBER VISION AWARDS 2012**

### **COMPETITION**

1. The *Intergrain Timber Vision Awards 2012* aim to encourage visionary use of timber in design. For each category entered, timber should make up a significant proportion of the building materials used. The competition categories are:
  - **Residential Interior:** The internal use of timber on any building used as a private residence.
  - **Residential Exterior:** The external use of timber on any building used as a private residence.
  - **Commercial Interior:** The internal use of timber on any commercial or industry building.
  - **Commercial Exterior:** The external use of timber on any commercial or industry building.
  - **Landscape:** The use of timber within the landscape of a commercial or residential building.
2. The same project may be entered in more than one category, provided it meets the above specified criteria relevant for each separate category entered.
3. A separate entry form is required for each category that the entrant participates in.
4. To be eligible to enter the *Intergrain Timber Vision Awards 2012*, all submitted projects must have been completed between **1 June 2010 and 23 June 2012**.
5. Information on how to enter the *Intergrain Timber Vision Awards 2012* and prizes form part of these Terms and Conditions. Participation in this competition is deemed acceptance of these Terms and Conditions.

### **PROMOTER**

6. The Promoter is Cabot's Australia a division of DuluxGroup (Australia) Pty Ltd (ABN 67 000 049 427) of 1956 Dandenong Road, Clayton 3168, Victoria, Australia.

### **ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY**

7. Entries open at **9.00 am** (AEST) on **Monday 16 April 2012** and close at **5.00 pm** (AEST) on **Saturday 23 June 2012**.
8. To be eligible to enter the *Intergrain Timber Vision Awards 2012*, entrants must: (i) be an Australian resident; and (ii) design and build an article as the entrants entry into the competition which falls within at least one of the five competition categories; and (iii) complete an online entry form available at the Intergrain website, [www.intergrain.com.au/awards](http://www.intergrain.com.au/awards).

9. Entrants must provide the following personal details: full name, organisation (if applicable), address, a day time contact number or mobile phone number and an email address.
10. Entrants must also provide the category that they are entering (either, residential interior, residential exterior, commercial interior, commercial exterior or Landscape), their project details including project name, address, contract name, architect, interior designer, landscaper, building/developer and photographer, and a project description (maximum of 250 words) which provides the judges with a short overview of the context of the building, the type of business (if relevant) and its location. Entries should also include the species of all timber(s) used. Please note that the use of Intergrain products is not a criteria for judging, however if Intergrain timber finishes have been used on the project, please specify the product details.
11. Entrants are required to provide digital photographs of the project they are entering. Images must be uploaded to the competition website ([www.intergrain.com.au/awards](http://www.intergrain.com.au/awards)) as part of the online entry process. Images of the project must be provided in non-compressed JPEG or TIF format, above 1MB in size, at least 300dpi and in colour. Entrants must ensure the name of each image supplied includes the entrant's name, project title and image number. Please note that professional photography is not required as long as the images provided are a good representation of the project. Entrants may submit a minimum of three images and a maximum of five, comprising a wide shot and close up shots.
12. By entering the ***Intergrain Timber Vision Awards 2012***, entrants agree to the Promoter's use of any submitted images for editorial or other promotional uses during the entry period and following conclusion of the entry period on **23 June 2012**. Entrants also agree to the Promoter cropping and altering any submitted images to suit editorial or other promotional uses during the entry period and following conclusion of the entry period on **23 June 2012**.

#### **NON-ELIGIBILITY**

13. Employees (and their immediate families) of the Promoter, participating retailers and agencies associated with this promotion are ineligible to enter.
14. The Promoter reserves the right, at any time, to verify the validity of entries and entrants (including an entrant's identity and address) and to disqualify any entrant who submits an entry that is not in accordance with these Terms and Conditions or who tampers with the entry process. Failure by the Promoter to enforce any of its rights at any stage does not constitute a waiver of those rights.
15. Incomplete and indecipherable entries and any entry which has incorrectly entered personal information or contact details shall be deemed an invalid entry.
16. Entries that are deemed, at the sole discretion of the Promoter, not to contain a significant proportion of timber or unoriginal will be disqualified.

## JUDGING

17. The Residential Interior, Residential Exterior, Commercial Interior, Commercial Exterior and Landscape categories will be judged independently by a panel of prestigious industry representatives. Judging will occur during July 2012. One winner will be selected from each competition category.
18. There will be five prizes awarded in total.
19. All winners will be notified in the week commencing **Monday 6 August 2012** and published online at [www.intergrain.com.au/awards](http://www.intergrain.com.au/awards) on **Monday 13 August 2012**.
20. This is a game of skill and chance plays no part in determining the winners. Each entry will be individually judged based on originality and creative merit of the project. The judges may select additional reserve entries which they determine to be the next best, and record them in order, in the case an invalid entry or ineligible entrant is selected as a winner.
21. The judges' decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.

## PRIZE

22. Each category winner will receive (i) a \$2,000 cash prize; (ii) their winning project published in the November 2012 issue of Architecture Australia and Intergrain product (maximum 200L). The Prize is not transferable or exchangeable.
23. Each prize can only be redeemed by the category winner as nominated on their entry form.

## GENERAL CONDITIONS

24. If this Promotion is interfered with in any way or is not capable of being conducted as reasonably anticipated due to any reason beyond the reasonable control of the Promoter, the Promoter reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to the fullest extent permitted by law (a) to disqualify any entrant; or (b) to modify, suspend, terminate or cancel the ***Intergrain Timber Vision Awards 2012***, as appropriate.
25. Except for any liability that cannot be excluded by law, the Promoter (including its officers, employees and agents) excludes all liability (including negligence), for any personal injury; or any loss or damage (including loss of opportunity); whether direct, indirect, special or consequential, arising in any way out of the Promotion, including, but not limited to, where arising out of the following: (a) any technical difficulties or equipment malfunction (whether or not under the Promoter's control); (b) any theft, unauthorised access or third party interference; (c) any entry or prize claim that is late, lost, altered, damaged or misdirected (whether or not after their receipt by the Promoter) due to any reason beyond the reasonable control of the Promoter; (d) any variation in prize value to that stated in these Terms and Conditions; (e) any tax liability incurred by a winner or entrant; or (f) use of the prize.
